This term in class we are learning about...

Our topic for this half term is 'Gods and Mortals' We'll learn about Apollo and the other gods who reign from Mount Olympus. We'll explore the land of Greece, where the sun scorches the wings of Icarus and Helen of Troy inspires the launch of a thousand ships. Using historical source materials, we'll research daily life in ancient Greece. We'll write diaries as Daedalus or Icarus and learn about epic battles.
