Important Reminders:

Year 3, Class 6b, have their PE session on a Monday afternoon. They have the opportunity to work with and learn from a fantastic gymnastics coach. Please ensure children have their PE kits in school so they are suitably dressed and ready to learn.

This term in class we are learning about...

Our topic for this half term is Misty Mountain Sierra'.
In art the children will be creating a 3D model of a mountain inspired from some of the mountains they will be learning about as well as learning how to weave to create a piece of inspired art. In D&T they will review the 3D mountain models they made..
In Geography, children will be asked to locate some of the major mountains of the world on maps and use an 8 point compass to discuss directions. They will learn about how to read maps and contour lines to read the heights of mountains and learn about the different types of mountains and how they are formed. They will also learn about why different plants grow in different areas of the world.
In Science, children will learn about and re-create a mini water cycle and investigate water evaporation rates. They will also learn about animals who have adapted to live in areas such as mountains.

Homework:

The children are enjoying their online homework and are becoming familiar with the routines in place. Homework is set, for maths and spelling, every Wednesday and it is to be handed in on the following Wednesday.
There are opportunities provided throughout the week for children to use school equipment to complete their homework if they are unable to do so at home. Please encourage your child to complete their homework on time as it supports their learning in the classroom.
