This term in class we are learning about...

Our topic for this half term is 'Gods and Mortals'

As the topic is largely a history based unit children will order events from Greek history into a timeline to learn about chronology. Research facts about Ancient Greek life and some famous Ancient Greeks too. They will learn about Ancient Greek soldiers, learn about the Battle of Marathon, and consider how this legend has continued into modern life.

Children will develop geography skills by learning about the location of Greece, how it has changed from Ancient Greek times countries around it, and learn about the human and physical features of the country.

Art & design and technology will allow children to practise and improve their sketching skills of Greek pots, and design a crown for a Greek Good or Goddess.

Homework:

The children are enjoying their online homework and are becoming familiar with the routines in place. Homework is set, for maths and spelling, every Wednesday and it is to be handed in on the following Wednesday.

There are opportunities provided throughout the week for children to use school equipment to complete their homework if they are unable to do so at home. Please encourage your child to complete their homework on time as it supports their learning in the classroom. Thank you.
