Important Reminders:

PE lessons for Year 2, both Class 5 and Class 6 children remain on Monday afternoons. Children will children will remain as one large class and taught my myself and Mr Druid. The school PE kit is: a plain white t-shirt and black trousers or shorts. Children are expected to have appropriate footwear such as trainers or indoor shoes. Please ensure your child brings the necessary clothing as PE is an important part of the school curriculum. This half term children will focus on developing Gymnastics skills.

This term in class we are learning about...

Our topic for this Autumn Term is 'The Scented Garden'

The focus for Class 6 this half term will mainly be Geography based learning which links hand in hand with our Science topic 'The Secret World of Plants'

As part of developing art and D&T skills children will explore and play with a range of tools as part of outdoor in the 'mud kitchen' to make different items. They will create different types of play dough using a range of materials and ingredients and make models of plants and design a fantasy garden for display.

In Geography, children will visit the local area or a Botanic Garden and make a simple map of the plants and trees using a suitable key. They will use photographs and pictures, locate plants in the local area and the world. They will research plants that would be found in woodlands in the UK and in the rainforest of Brazil – create something to show how they are similar and different.

Homework:

The children are continuing with their online homework and are becoming familiar with the routines in place. Homework is set, for Maths and Spelling, every Monday and it is to be completed by the end of the week. Paper copies are also sent home for children's revision of spellings and arithmetic.

There are opportunities provided throughout the week for children to use school equipment to complete their homework if they are unable to do so at home. Please encourage your child to complete their homework on time as it supports their learning in the classroom. Thank you from you support.
