Important Reminders:

This term in class we are learning about...

Our topic for this Autumn Term is 'Scented Garden'

The focus for Class 5 this half term will mainly be Geography and Science based learning. This term will also be covering a lot of DT. Children will be learning about the plants that grow in our local area and comparing them with the plants that grow in the rainforest.

In Science the children will be learning all about how plants grow, the life cycle of a plant and they will be even growing their own plants.

Homework:

The children are continuing with their online homework and are becoming familiar with the routines in place. Homework is set, for Maths and Spelling, every Monday and it is to be completed by the end of the week. Paper copies are also sent home for children's revision of spellings and arithmetic.
