Our topic for this half term will be, 'Oceans'

Your child will be learning about:

History – Captain James Cook. In Y1 children have to know about the lives of significant individuals in the past who have contributed to national and international achievements.

Geography – The voyages of Captain Cook. I Y1 children have to be able to name and locate the world's seven continents and five oceans. They have to be able to use world maps and atlases and be able to identify seasonal and daily weather patterns in the United Kingdom and the location of hot and cold areas of the world.

DT – Moving pictures of Cook's ship, Endeavour.
