Year 5 – Class 10 Autumn 1

Important Reminders:

Children in Year 5 are able to walk home on their own, but permission needs to be given.

PE will be on a Tuesday afternoon. We will be outside this half-term and children will be learning some **rugby skills**. Children may come into school in their PE kit on a Tuesday.

On a Thursday, we also complete our weekly mile, so children may bring trainers to change into on this day, if they wish to.

This term in class we are learning about...

When we first return to school we will be learning about a Greek impressionist artist called Mina Papatheodorou-Valkariki, who creates images of athletes and sports cars.

In English and Guided Reading we will be using a book called 'Skellig' by the author Anthony Brown. From this we will be developing our skills in our writing.

Our topic this term is called '**Mayans**', which is learning all about the Ancient Civilisation from Mexico. We will study this topic until Christmas!

In Art, our focus will be on an artist called Frida Khalo, and we will be recreating some self-portraits in her style.

In Geography, children will be learning about the country of Mexico, learning about the lines of latitude and also learning about time zones.

In History, children will be learning the timeline of the Maya, researching what life was like for them and also learning about an ancient ball game they used to play.

Our Science topic this half-term is called '**Changes and Reproduction**'.

Homework:

We will continue to be set homework online for maths and spelling each Monday, which needs to be completed by Friday. A paper copy will also be sent home each week.

Banded books and library books will be checked weekly and replaced once completed.

Please ensure your child brings their banded book into school each day, and try to read with your children at home 3 times a week. Children also have access to electronic books through the Reading Buddy website.
