This term in class we are learning about...

This term we will be beginning our new topic 'Invaders'. This is a history based topic where the children will learn all about the Anglo Saxons, the Scots and the Vikings. Children will:

- Complete Celtic prints
- Examine artefacts to see what they can learn about Anglo Saxon Britain
- Examine runes and attempt to write alliteration poetry using runes
- Explore where the Vikings came from and why they invaded Britain
- Study the significance of Anglo Saxon kings during the Viking period
- Learn about King Ethelred and when and why Danegeld was introduced
- Explain key aspects of Viking life
- Compare the modern day legal system to that of the Vikings and Anglo Saxons
- Explain how the last Anglo Saxon kings shaped Britain

Homework:

Online homework for maths, spelling and Bedrock will be set on a Monday and must be completed by Friday each week. Please ensure your child is accessing Reading Buddy at home for extra reading. If you require your child's passwords, please let me know. Reading books should be taken home and returned to school each day. We ask that you read at least 3 times each week with your child as this will support all areas of the curriculum. Thank you.
