Read, Write, Inc

If your child is due to begin Reception in September, they will begin small Read, Write, Inc sessions this term. Each week your child will learn a new sound and a practice sheet will be sent home. Nursery Door Opening and Closing Times:

Morning Nursery

Entry - door opens 08:50am, door closes 09:00am
Collection - door opens 11:35am, door closes 11:45am

Afternoon Nursery

Entry - door opens 12:30pm, door closes 12:40pm
Collection - door opens 3:10pm, door closes 3:30pm

The doors will be closed promptly at these times to ensure the nursery session can begin. If the door is closed when you arrive, please take your child to the main school office to avoid disruption to the session. If you need to collect your child early, children will need to be collected via the school office.

Important Reminders:

Please ensure your child attends nursery with a coat/jacket at all times. Please be mindful that the weather can quickly change during the session. As we move into the summer, please apply sun cream to your child before the session and provide a summer cap. If your child attends nursery full days, please apply sun cream before the session and provide a labelled bottle of sun cream so staff can reapply before the afternoon session.

A gentle reminder that the school grounds has a strict no dog policy. Dogs are not permitted past the main school gate.
