This term in class we are learning about...

In History this half term, our topic is The Romans. In this topic, our knowledge drivers are Culture and Pastimes and Settlements and Society. Within this topic, we will focus on the following questions:

- Who were Romulus and Remus? Why did people enjoy watching violent events at the Colosseum?
- When did Christianity become the official religion of the Roman Empire?
- Compare and contrast daily life in Rome with that in Roman Britain.

In Geography, our topic 'Landscapes' sits within Human and Physical Processes and Human and Physical Features. Within this topic, we will focus on the following questions:

- What are the two types of weathering? Give some examples of where the effects of chemical weathering can be seen.
- What is the name of a smaller river that flows into a larger river? What is the name for the beginning of a river? What is the name for the end of a river?
- Describe the physical process of plate tectonics. Describe the physical process that forms volcanoes, fold mountains and block mountains.

Homework:
