Nursery Learning

This half term our topic is 'All About Me'. We will be learning about who we are as a person, our families and making friends. If the door is closed when you arrive, please take your child to the main school office to avoid disruption to the session. If you need to collect your child early, children will need to be collected via the school office.

Important Reminders:

If another adult is collecting your child at the end of session, please inform myself, another member of staff or contact the school office. A password is required. If you have not already provided a password, please ensure you do this immediately. Adults must be over the age of eighteen years old to collect children from nursery.

At nursery, we promote independence. Your child will be encouraged to take off their own coat and hang up their belongings on their peg. Please remind and encourage your child of this routine. Staff will be present to support your child if required. If your child is toilet training, please ensure you share efforts with staff to ensure consistency for your child. Please provide a bag including pants, socks, trousers, wipes and nappies or pull-ups, so your child can be changed if required. Thank you for your co-operation.
